A Canon rep even told me to never use the camera to play or offload videos why advertise it as a feature if its such a bad idea. He advised that you should buy a cheaper video camera to do those types of tasks. Good advise, but even if you do, remember to add that cost to the purchase price of the GL2 Disgruntled. Have to order battery and cord elsewhere. Buy from this gent whenever possible. Its hard to download to your computer. But the quality and accessibility is great!!!
