From the standpoint of fluid dynamics and structural strength, an eggshaped vessel is about the best possible solution. This type of construction, however, is comparatively expensive, therefore, its use is usually restricted to largescale sewage treatment plants. The Chinese fixeddome

The hemispherical CAMARTEC design is optimized in structural strength, but does not make optimal use of the excavation required. Their disadvantage lies in their less favorable surface volume ratio. The cylinder should have a height equal to its diameter. Prone cylinders have become quite popular on farms, since they are frequently the more favorable solution for smallscale biomethanation. Cuboid digesters are often employed in batchfed systems used primarily for fermenting solid material, so that fluid dynamics are of little interest. The gas is stored in the upper part of the digester. When gas production commences, the slurry is displaced into the compensating tank. Gas pressure increases with the volume of gas stored, i.e. with the height difference between the two slurry levels. The gasholder floats either directly on the fermentation slurry or in a water jacket of its own. The gas is collected in the gas drum, which rises or moves down, according to the amount of gas stored. The gas is stored in the upper part of the balloon. The edge of the pit is reinforced with a ring of masonry that also serves as anchorage for the gasholder. The gasholder can be made of metal or plastic sheeting. If plastic sheeting is used, it must be attached to a quadratic wooden frame that extends down into the slurry and is anchored in place to counter its buoyancy. The requisite gas pressure is achieved by placing weights on the gasholder. An overflow point in the peripheral wall serves as the slurry outlet. The designs are selected in a way that all the typical elements of modern biogas technology appear at least once. All designs are aboveground, which is common in Europe. Underground structures, however, do exist. At times, the substrate is also preheated in the mixing pit in order to avoid a temperature shock inside the digester. To optimize the flow of substrate, large digesters have a longish channel form. Large digesters are almost always agitated by slow rotating paddles or rotors or by injected biogas. Cofermenters have two or more separated fermenters. The gas can be collected inside the digester, then usually with a flexible cover. The digester can also be filled completely and the gas stored in a separate gasholder. It can be placed either directly above the substrate, then it acts like a balloon plant, or in a separate gasbag. The store can be open like conventional open liquid manure storage or closed and connected to the gasholder to capture remaining gas production. Normally, the store is not heated and only agitated before the slurry is spread on the field. The thermopower unit has the advantage, that the required energy can be produced in any mixture of gas and fossil energy. It can, therefore, react to periods of low gas production and high energy requirements or vice versa. Each design and each fermentation material is suitable for batch filling, but batch plants require high labor input. As a major disadvantage, their gas output is not steady. They empty automatically through the overflow whenever new material is filled in. Therefore, the substrate must be fluid and homogeneous. Continuous plants are suitable for rural households as the necessary work fits well into the daily routine. Gas production is constant, and higher than in batch plants. Today, nearly all biogas plants are operating on a continuous mode. The slowly digested strawtype material is fed in about twice a year as a batch load. The dung is added and removed regularly.

Renewable organic feedstocks are used as a the source of energy for the process. The nutrientrich solids resulting from the digestion can be used as a fertiliser subsequently.
